DAY 4 READ: 1 John 5:12 (KBC Study Bible, page 1359)

DO: The apostle John shared the good news with others by writing a letter so others would know how to have eternal life through Jesus Christ. Find a piece of paper and write a letter to a friend telling them the good news about Jesus.

PRAY: God, please help the person who receives this letter to trust in Jesus. Thank You that You offer salvation to everyone. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 5 READ: Matthew 28:18-20 (KBC Study Bible, page 1069)

THINK: Before He went into Heaven, Jesus gave a big assignment to His followers, which is to help others know how to become followers of Jesus. He also promised to be with you wherever you go. That’s good news you can share!

PRAY: Dear Jesus, I believe that You are with me to help me tell others how to know You. Thank You for the promise of eternal life in Heaven with You. In Jesus’ name, amen.
