Character Word

Contentment – being happy with what I have

The people of Israel were not <u>content</u> and demanded that God give them a king.

Weekly Challenge

Turn to the tip-in page "God Is..." (between pages 434-435) in your KBC Study Bible. Because God has all these attributes, He can be the King of your life through trusting Jesus as your Savior. Talk with your parents or grandparents about which description of God sticks out to you most and why.

DAY 1 READ: Genesis 2 (KBC Study Bible, pages 2-3)

THINK: God chose the nation of Israel to be His special people. They were to be holy, set apart for God. Because Jesus paid for your sin, He made it possible for you to become one of God's chosen people. God loves you and wants you to be His child. Commit your life to Jesus today.

PRAY: God, I thank You that for whoever trusts in Jesus is chosen by You to be Your child. In Jesus' name, amen.

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DAY 2 READ: 1 Peter 2:9-12 (KBC Study Bible, page 1348)

THINK: God wants you to proclaim His promises. How do you do that? Learn what they are by studying the Bible. Tell others what you learn about God. It's good news, meant to be shared. Who can you tell about God's promise of salvation today?

PRAY: Thank You, God, that I have Your Bible and get to go to Beach Club to learn more about You. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3 READ: 2 Peter 1:3 (KBC Study Bible, page 1352)

DO: Where do you get what you need to live God's way? The Bible says that God provides what you need. Make a list of all the things God has given you to live for Him. Ask God to help you remember that God gives you everything you need to know how to live His way.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for giving me all these good things so I can know more about You. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4 READ: Philippians 2:14-15 (KBC Study Bible, page 1295)

DO: God wants you to show others that you are content by doing things without grumbling or complaining. Think about a time you complained to someone you live with. Go tell them you're sorry and thank them for something they have done for you.

PRAY: I am sorry, God, for complaining when You have given me many things. Help me to remember to be thankful and content. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 READ: Philippians 4:4-8 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1297-1298)

THINK: Rejoicing in the Lord is something you can do to help you be more content. Think of something you can rejoice about, praising God for what He has done for you. Now celebrate! You can even clap your hands or shout out loud. Be happy and rejoice in God!

PRAY: God, help me to rejoice in my life no matter what happens. Remind me that You have everything I need to be content. In Jesus' name, amen.

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
