DAY 1 READ: Deuteronomy 7:9 (KBC Study Bible, page 194)

DO: Count all the way to a thousand (1,000). How long did it take you? The Bible says that God is faithful to keep His promises to a thousand generations. Try to imagine how long that is. There is no one as dependable as God. Thank Him for His faithfulness and dependability.

PRAY: Thank You, God, that I can depend on Your faithfulness to last longer than I can imagine. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 2 READ: Malachi 3:6a (KBC Study Bible, page 1018)

DO: Look at a picture of yourself from when you were younger. Lots of things about you have changed since then. But God hasn't changed at all. God does not change His mind, His characteristics, His plan, or anything else. God is the same forever. Now that's something for which you can be thankful!
