Character Word

Confidence – trust; a feeling of assurance or certainty

Peter and the believers placed their <u>confidence</u> in God despite persecution.

Weekly Challenge

Read the tip-in pages "Spending Time with God" (between pages 242-243) in your KBC Study Bible. Spending time with God and learning His word will help boost your confidence in God. Make it a priority to spend time with God every day. Today, you just learned a portion of Isaiah 41:10. Write out the entire verse and put it somewhere you will see it and read it every day. Share with your parents that instead of being afraid, you can have confidence that God is always with you and will strengthen you and help you.



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DAY 1 READ: Matthew 4:18-22 (KBC Study Bible, page 1028) THINK: Jesus chose Peter to be one of his 12 disciples. Peter walked with Jesus, saw Jesus do miracles and heard Jesus teach. Peter had confidence in Jesus because he spent time with Jesus. PRAY: Thank You, God, for the stories in the Bible that teach me about people who followed You. In Jesus' name, amen. DAY 2 READ: Matthew 8:14-15 (KBC Study Bible, page 1035) DO: Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. Write a name of someone you know that is sick. Peter had confidence that Jesus was God's Son and could heal the sick. PRAY: God, please be with _____ who is sick. Heal them if it is in Your will. In Jesus' name, amen. DAY 3 READ: Acts 12:1-4 (KBC Study Bible, page 1201) DO: Read "Bible Treasures" (KBC Study Bible, page 1202). Peter could have been killed, but God rescued him. God had a plan for Peter to continue to spread the Good News about Jesus. God has a plan for you, too. PRAY: God, I put my confidence in You. When I face hard times, I will trust in You, God. In Jesus' name, amen. **DAY 4** READ: Psalm 27:1 (KBC Study Bible, page 576) **DO:** What are you afraid of? The Bible tells us the Lord is our strength. We have no need to fear. Repeat this sentence: "I will not fear. The Lord is my strength." PRAY: You are my strength, God. Please help me to not be afraid. In Jesus' name, amen. **DAY 5** READ: Isaiah 41:10a (KBC Study Bible, page 768) DO: Replace the word 'you' with your name. Say the verse with your name 3 times. PRAY: Thank You, God, for giving me strength. Thank You for teaching

me that I can always trust You. Thank You that I can choose confidence

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
