2 Kings 22:1-30

(KBC Study Bible, pages 412-413)

Character Word

Respect – to show a high or special importance to someone or something; honor one another

God’s word is the source of all truth and He wants us to read it and respect it.

Because I know God’s word is truth, I show respect in how I take care of it.

Memory Link

“I rejoice at Your word as one who finds great treasure.”

Psalms 119:162 (KBC Study Bible, page 648)

Weekly Challenge

Read tip-in pages “Spending Time with God” (between pages 242-243). Reading the Bible and praying every day will help you learn more about God. Find a quiet place to read your Bible every day.

DAY 1 READ: Psalms 119:162 (KBC Study Bible, page 648)

THINK: Did you know God’s word is more valuable than anything else? God’s word is true, reliable, perfect and never changes. You can know God personally and learn about Him by reading your Bible every day.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for the gift of Your word. Help me to realize what a treasure it is. In Jesus’ name, amen.

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DAY 2 **READ: 2 Timothy 3:16-17** (KBC Study Bible, page 1320)

DO: Find the tip-in page “About the Bible” in your KBC Study Bible (following page 242). Read “Who Wrote the Bible” to discover how men were inspired by God and wrote down God’s message to us.

PRAY: God, I thank You for sharing your message with men who wrote it down. Thank You that Your message is true. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 3 **READ: Psalm 119:105** (KBC Study Bible, page 646)

DO: Find a flashlight and shine it in a dark place. Notice how the darkness prevents you from seeing things, but the light reveals what’s there. God’s word is like a light that shines the way on a dark path. When you read the Bible every day, you’ll know which way to go in every circumstance.

PRAY: God, help me trust and depend on Your word to make right decisions every day. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 4 **READ: Isaiah 40:6-8** (KBC Study Bible, page 766)

THINK: What happens to a flower when it’s left out in the heat without any water or shade? It wilts and dies, fading away. That’s the picture this verse makes for us. All people will eventually die, but God’s word never ends. It stands firm and stays true forever.

PRAY: God, You never change. Thank You that Your word stands firm forever. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 5 **READ: Luke 11:28** (KBC Study Bible, page 1124)

THINK: Jesus said that people will be blessed when they hear and obey God’s word. When you read the Bible, consider what God is saying to you through what you read. How can you obey God’s word today?

PRAY: Father, help me listen to what You say to me through Your word and help me obey it. In Jesus’ name, amen.

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EASTER

Jesus Is Crucified

John 19:17-20:18

(KBC Study Bible, pages 1177-1180)

Character Word

Humility – opposite of prideful, arrogant and conceited; thinking of others more than yourself

Jesus showed humility by leaving heaven’s glory to become human and pay the price for my sin.

I can know that Jesus humbled Himself to pay for my sin.

Memory Link

“He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.”

Philippians 2:8b (KBC Study Bible, page 1295)

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DAY 1 **READ: Matthew 28:1-8** (KBC Study Bible, page 1068)

DO: Make plans with your family to go to church on Easter Sunday. Remind them that Easter is a holiday to celebrate Jesus being raised from the dead. The best way to celebrate is by worshipping Jesus alongside other believers.

PRAY: Jesus, I praise You for coming back from the dead. Thank You for defeating death so that I can be forgiven. Amen.

DAY 2 **READ: John 19:28-30** (KBC Study Bible, page 1178)

DO: The final words Jesus said on the cross are, "It is finished." Read "Digging In" in your KBC Study Bible (page 1178) to discover what it means that Jesus finished His work. You can be free from sin because Jesus paid it all.

PRAY: God, thank You for sending Jesus to pay for my sin. Amen.

DAY 3 **READ: Philippians 2:8b** (KBC Study Bible, page 1295)

THINK: Jesus did what no one else could do. In dying on the cross, He put your needs above His own. He also did what no one else could do when He was raised from the dead. Jesus is alive in heaven today.

PRAY: I praise you, Jesus, for Your humble sacrifice and for Your victorious resurrection. Amen.

DAY 4 **READ: John 19:17-19** (KBC Study Bible, pages 1177-1178)

DO: As you walk or drive through your neighborhood, see how many cross shapes you can find. For example, street signs, light poles or fences. Each time you see something in the shape of a cross, you can remember how Jesus humbly sacrificed Himself when He died on the cross.

PRAY: God, thank You for the cross. I believe Jesus died for my sins. Help me, like Jesus did, to humbly put the needs of others before my own. Amen.

DAY 5 **READ: John 20:30-31** (KBC Study Bible, page 1181)

THINK: Do you know why John wrote his gospel? He wrote it so that people will believe that Jesus is the Christ, sent by God to save people from sin. What do you believe about Jesus?

PRAY: Father, I believe what the Bible says about Jesus is true. I believe You sent Jesus to pay for my sin. Thank you! Amen.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for our KiDs Beach Club® this year! Thank You for this time to learn more

DAY 2 READ: Deuteronomy 12:28 (KBC Study Bible, page 200)

DO: On Day 1 you found the table of contents in your Bible and some extra pages in the back of your Bible. What else is in your Bible – pictures? Your Bible reading today says to observe and obey God’s word. Talk with an adult about what that means

PRAY: Dear God, help me to obey You and depend on You when I am at school, at home with my family, and with my friends. In Jesus’ name, amen

DAY 3 READ: John 15:12-17 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1172-1173)

THINK: God has chosen you to be His friend and to follow His commandments. Verse 17 says to love one another. How can you show love to another person today?

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for loving me today and always. Thank You for giving me instructions in Your Bible to love one another. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 4 READ: Romans 12:18 (KBC Study Bible, page 1244)

DO: God depends on you to live peacefully with everyone just like this Bible verse says. Think about how to live peacefully with your brothers and/or sisters, your classmates. What can you do to help others get along with each other and live peacefully?

PRAY: God, help me to live peacefully with everyone and to always depend on You. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 5 READ: Deuteronomy 5:33a (KBC Study Bible, page 193)

DO: Reread all of this week’s Bible verses. Which one was your favorite? Why? Tell a friend about KiDs Beach Club® and invite them to club this upcoming week.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for our KiDs Beach Club®! Help me to read my Bible every day and depend on Your word to live my life every day. In Jesus’ name, amen.

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LESSON 1

God Creates Adam & Eve

Genesis 1:26 - 2:23

(KBC Study Bible, pages 1-4)

Character Word

Con dence – trust; a feeling of assurance or certainty

God’s power in creation and love for people gives us confidence in who He is.

I can have confidence in God knowing that He created me and that He cares for me.

Memory Link

“So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.”

Genesis 1:27 (KBC Study Bible, page 2)

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DAY 1 READ: Genesis 1:1 (KBC Study Bible, page 1)

DO: God created everything you see out of nothing; the sky, the earth, water, animals and people. He simply spoke and they appeared. You can be confident in God's power as Creator.

PRAY: I praise You, God, for Your creation. I believe You spoke it all into being. You are an amazing God. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 2 READ: Genesis 1:27 (KBC Study Bible, page 2)

DO: Look at your reflection in a mirror. That's your image looking back at you. The Bible says God created all people in His image. That means you were created to reflect God's character. You can be confident that God loves you enough to make you in His image.

PRAY: Dear God, I believe You created me in Your image and there is no one like me. Thank You for loving me and making me special In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 READ: Genesis 1:31 (KBC Study Bible, page 2)

DO: Check out the "Digging In" box on page 2 of your KBC Study Bible. It's amazing to think how special God made people, including you. He loves you and wants you to love Him too.

PRAY: God, I love You. Thank You for loving me, too. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 READ: Genesis 2:15-17 (KBC Study Bible, page 3)

THINK: Adam and Eve broke God's rule and caused sin to enter the world. What's sin? Sin is disobeying God, breaking God's law and doing things your own way instead of God's way. Who sins? Everyone.

PRAY: God, I'm sorry for my sin. Thank You for offering forgiveness from sin through Jesus. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 READ: 1 John 1:8-9 (KBC Study Bible, page 1355)

DO: Even though Adam and Eve sinned against God, God still loved them and protected them from more harm. God loves you like that, too. Even though you've sinned, God sent Jesus to pay for your sin. You can be confident in God's love for you.

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LESSON 2

Cain Gets Angry

Genesis 4:1-15

(KBC Study Bible, pages 6-7)

Character Word

Self-Control – *doing something even when I do not feel like it*

Cain lacked self-control over his emotions and actions.

I can have self-control over my emotions and actions.

Memory Link

“Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them.”

Matthew 7:12a (KBC Study Bible, page 1033)

Weekly Challenge

Want to shock your parents? Use self-control. Challenge yourself to see how long you can continue to respect your parents with your obedience and attitude. An hour? A day? All week? Make notes of times you used self-control and tell your parents your surf team leader how well you did.

DAY 1 READ: Ephesians 6:1-3 (KBC Study Bible, page 1291)

THINK: God commands that you honor your father and your mother. That means treating your parents with respect by your self-controlled attitude and actions. Respectful obedience to your parents is also respectful obedience to God.

PRAY: God, help me to be respectful to my parents every day. I want to honor my parents and honor You, too. Amen.

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DAY 2 **READ: Romans 12:10** (KBC Study Bible, page 1244)

DO: Gather two paper cups. Place a handful of dried beans in one of the cups. Each time you use self-control, and do what is right, move a bean to the other cup. Your goal is to use self-control so much that, over time, you move all the beans to the other cup.

PRAY: Dear God, please help me develop self-control. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3 **READ: Genesis 4:6-8** (KBC Study Bible, page 6)

THINK: Cain didn't have self-control or treat Abel with respect. Cain let his jealousy get so out of control that he killed his own brother. We need God's help to live with self-control and treat others with respect even when it's hard.

PRAY: God, forgive me when I act out in anger. I need Your help to have self-control and treat others with respect. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4 **READ: Matthew 7:12a** (KBC Study Bible, page 1033)

THINK: This week's memory link is sometimes called "The Golden Rule." How do you think it got that name? Maybe because these wise words have great value, like gold. But they're only words until you live them out. How will you use self-control and treat others with respect today?

PRAY: God, I want to treat others respectfully, the way I want to be treated. Please help me. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 **READ: Exodus 20:3-17** (KBC Study Bible, pages 85-86)

DO: Take a look at "The 10 Commandments" in your KBC Study Bible (before page 243). These important rules from God can help you know how to respect God and respect others. Which one will you work on today?

PRAY: Thank You, God, for giving us rules to help us know how to live. Help me follow them with self-control. In Jesus' name, amen.

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DO: Gather two paper cups. Place a handful of dried beans in one of the cups. Each time you show respect, love or honor to someone, move a bean to the other cup. Your goal is to show so much respect that, over time, you move all the beans to the other cup.

(KBC Study Bible, page 16)

Character Word

Kindness – a friendly, good-natured attitude toward others

God was pleased with Abram. Abram had been kind to Lot, and God was kind to Abram.

With God’s help, I can be kind and get along with others.

Memory Link

“Let there be no strife between you and me.”

Genesis 13:8a (KBC Study Bible, page 16)

Weekly Challenge

Count the number of times each family member shows kindness this week. Thank them each time you notice kindness.

DAY 1 READ: Colossians 3:12-13 (KBC Study Bible, page 1302)

THINK: Think about friends and family that you feel comfortable with and want to be around. What characteristics do they have that you admire?

PRAY: Jesus, please help me to focus more on how I act and to treat everyone kindly. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

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Memory Link

“Let there be no strife between you and me.”

Genesis 13:8a (KBC Study Bible, page 16)

Weekly Challenge

THINK: As you read these verses, replace the word "love" with your name. Does it stay true? Do you need to change your heart and behavior?

PRAY: Jesus, all of these words describe You. Help me be more like You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 **READ: Ruth 2:20** (KBC Study Bible, page 283)

SHARE: Talk to someone in your family about what you learned this week about kindness. If your family has been kind, remind your family member about that time and talk about how you can be kind in the future also.

PRAY: Jesus, thank You for my family and giving me people to depend on. Help me to show them kindness every day. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 **READ: Luke 6:31** (KBC Study Bible, page 1113)

DO: Take a piece of paper and trace your hand on it. On each of the fingers, write a name of someone who deserves a "pat on the back."

PRAY: Jesus, thank You for these people in my life. Bless them. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 2 **READ: Joshua 2:11-16** (KBC Study Bible, page 227)

DO: These verses show that people can be kind to others, even when they are not related to them. Look for a way to do something nice at school for a person you do not know.

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LESSON 5

1 Samuel 13:1-14

(KBC Study Bible, pages 298-299)

Character Word

Contentment – being happy with what I have

Saul was not content to wait on Samuel.

Memory Link

“Now godliness with contentment is great gain.”

1 Timothy 6:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 1315)

Weekly Challenge

Using each letter in the word contentment – write a word that begins with each letter of something you are thankful for and which you will choose to be content. Then pray and thank God for these things and share them with family members. You can add to this list over the summer.

DAY 1 READ: Colossians 3:15a (KBC Study Bible, page 1302)

THINK: Think about the word peace. What does it mean to have peace? Draw a picture of something peaceful.

PRAY: Lord, thank You for being in charge of my life and for loving me. Please give me peace today in everything I do. In Jesus' name, amen.

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With Jesus' help, I can learn to be content with what I have.

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DAY 2 **READ: Acts 16:30-31** (KBC Study Bible, page 1210)

DO: If you believe in Jesus and have asked Him to be your forever friend, tell someone how you made that choice. If you haven't yet, that's ok. You can tell someone what you've learned about Jesus.

PRAY: God, thank You for sending Your Son Jesus. You always take care of me and I am grateful for that. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3 **READ: Romans 8:28** (KBC Study Bible, page 1239)

THINK: God knows what we need, and He will provide for our needs. We can remember that truth and put our trust in God. When we do, it's easier to be content.

PRAY: God, please help me be content with what You give me. Thank You for taking care of my needs. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4 **READ: Acts 16:25** (KBC Study Bible, page 1210)

DO: Paul and Silas sang praises to God. Write down some things you know about God. Take time to praise Him for those things.

PRAY: God, You are mighty and wise. I praise You for who You are. Thank You! In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 **READ: Luke 12:15** (KBC Study Bible, page 1126)

THINK: Think of something you treasure. Is it an item you can hold? Is it a person or a place? God loves you more than you could ever imagine. You are His treasure.

PRAY: Lord, thank You for loving me. You are in charge and know what's best. Help me to remember that. In Jesus' name, amen.

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LESSON 6

Jesus Teaches When to Forgive

Matthew 18:21-35

(KBC Study Bible, page 1051)

Character Word

Forgiveness – *To pardon or to release someone from the consequences of a wrong; does not hold a grudge*

Jesus told a story to teach a lesson about forgiveness.

Because God has forgiven me, I can forgive others.

Memory Link

“For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive.”

Psalm 86:5 (KBC Study Bible, page 620)

Weekly Challenge

Try counting the number of times your family members forgive each other.

DAY 1 READ: Matthew 6:14-15 (KBC Study Bible, page 1032)

THINK: God tells us to forgive so we can also be forgiven. Think of someone who has hurt you. Decide today that you will forgive that person. Write their name in the blank below in the prayer. Ask God to help you to forgive.

PRAY: God, help me to forgive people who hurt me. I choose today to forgive _____. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

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Forgiveness – *treating someone as though he or she never hurt me*

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DAY 2 READ: Psalm 86:5 (KBC Study Bible, page 620)

SHARE: Tell a friend or a family member what this verse says about God. Tell them that He is good and ready to forgive. He is abundant in mercy to all those who call upon Him.

PRAY: God, thank You for Your goodness and mercy. I can feel happy knowing that You are always ready to forgive. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 READ: 1 John 2:3-6 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1355-1356)

DO: Read the heading above verse 3. If you want to be sure that you know Jesus, what is the test? Keeping His commandments is the proof. We are to walk just as He walked. That is why we must forgive even when we don't want to. We forgive others out of obedience to Jesus.

PRAY: Lord, help me to keep Your commandments and obey You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 READ: Matthew 18:11 (KBC Study Bible, page 1050)

DO: Read the Digging In section on the bottom of page 1051. Underline one or two things about Jesus and what this tells us He came to do.

PRAY: Thank You, Jesus, for coming to show us what God is like. Thank You for showing us how to love others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 READ: Matthew 18:21-22 (KBC Study Bible, page 1051)

DO: Peter asked Jesus a question. Jesus wants to teach us and give us answers so we know how to live. Think of a question about this story or any part of the Bible and write it down in the margin. Take it back to Beach Club® next week and ask your surf team leader your question.

PRAY: Thank You, Father, for giving us Your Word. Thank You for telling us all we need to know about You in the Bible. Help me to learn more about You and how You want me to treat others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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LESSON 7

Parable of the Two Sons

Matthew 21:23-32

(KBC Study Bible, page 1055)

Character Word

Obedience – doing what I am told to do with a happy, submissive spirit

Jesus told a parable about two sons to teach a lesson about salvation and obedience.

With God’s help, I can obey with a happy and submissive spirit.

Memory Link

“But be doers of the word, and not hearers only.”

James 1:22a (KBC Study Bible, page 1341)

Weekly Challenge

Work this week to always obey by doing what the Bible tells me to do. It won’t always be easy but you can ask God to help you. Get a piece of paper and put a sticker on it every time you obey your parents and teachers this week. Bring your sheet next week and we will celebrate your obedient choices.

DAY 1 READ: Matthew 21:28-31a (KBC Study Bible, page 1055)

DO: It’s never too late to change our behavior and seek forgiveness, just like the first son who changed his mind and did what was right. Create a “repentance and forgiveness” journal to write or draw about times you’ve made mistakes and how you made things right.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to pay for my sin. Help me choose to obey. In Jesus’ name, amen.

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DAY 2 READ: Genesis 37:1-35 (KBC Study Bible, pages 45-47)

DO: Joseph showed incredible obedience to God even after his brothers sold him into bondage. Joseph was falsely placed in jail, but remained faithful and obedient to God saving many from famine.

PRAY: Dear Jesus, please give me faith like Joseph and help me to be obedient when I am treated wrong by my friends. In Jesus' name, amen!

DAY 3 READ: Exodus 3:11-18 (KBC Study Bible, page 65)

DO: Was Moses a mighty character of obedience? God called Moses to lead the Israelites out of bondage in Egypt and guided the people through the wilderness, being obedient to God's voice. Moses heard God's voice.

PRAY: Dear God, please give me open ears and an open heart to hear you just like Moses did when he heard your voice at the burning bush. Help me to be still and listen to you and to obey your word the Bible. In Jesus' name, amen!

DAY 4 READ: Luke 1:26-37 (KBC Study Bible, page 1101)

DO: Mary's obedience is evident in her acceptance of the angel Gabriel's message that she would give birth to a son whose name is Jesus. Her response represents her willingness to be obedient to God's plan.

PRAY: Dear Jesus, I don't always respond with a heart of obedience. Help me to serve you just like Mary. Help me to think of your plans and see that with you nothing is impossible and please forgive me when I don't. In Jesus' name, amen!

DAY 5 READ: Genesis 22:1-19 (KBC Study Bible, pages 25-26)

DO: Abraham is often talked about because of his faith and obedience, especially in the story of how God asked him to offer Isaac, his only son, back to God. Amazingly, while Abraham was prepared to obey God's command and give up his son, God saw Abraham's obedience, so an angel spoke and said there's a ram now let it replace Isaac for the burnt offering.

PRAY: Dear God, please guide me to live my life in obedience just like Abraham and let me see your way when I am not following your path. Help me to love your word to you read and to obey it. Thank you for loving me, hearing my prayer for giving me direction today. In Jesus' name, amen!

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LESSON 8

Jesus Heals Bartimaeus

Mark 10:46-52

(KBC Study Bible, pages 1088-1089)

Character Word

Compassion – *feeling for another's need and helping that one without expecting anything in return*

Jesus showed compassion to Bartimaeus by healing his blindness.

I can follow Jesus' example by showing compassion to others.

Memory Link

"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

Mark 10:47b (KBC Study Bible, page 1089)

Weekly Challenge

Thank your parents each time they show you compassion this week.

DAY 1 READ: 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 (KBC Study Bible, page 1263)

THINK: The greatest way you can show compassion is to share the good news about Jesus and tell about the compassion Jesus has to forgive sin and give eternal life.

PRAY: Jesus, help me share the good news with my friends and family that You died for all our sins, were buried and that You rose again the third day according to the Scriptures. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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DAY 2 READ: Matthew 14:14 (KBC Study Bible, page 1045)

DO: This verse shows how Jesus acted immediately when He saw a need. Think of a way you can act immediately to show compassion to help someone right away.

PRAY: Lord, I want to be more like You and show compassion to those in need around me. Give me the courage to do good for the people You have put in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 READ: James 5:11b (KBC Study Bible, page 1344)

SHARE: This verse tells us about who God is, that He is very compassionate and merciful. Share this wonderful news to your family, let them know they too can know a merciful and compassionate God.

PRAY: Thank You, Lord, for letting me learn more about You. Thank You for showing me so much mercy and compassion. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 READ: Isaiah 49:13 (KBC Study Bible, page 780)

DO: God has compassion on sick and hurting people. Go visit someone that you know is sick or mail them a get-well card.

PRAY: Lord, help me to make someone feel better today by my actions and concern. Help me to think more of others than I do myself. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 READ: Psalm 145:9 (KBC Study Bible, page 660)

SHARE: Share with your friends at school that God wants the best for us. Tell them God loves them and is full of compassion and cares for them.

PRAY: Dear God, help me to share Your love with a hurting friend. Help them to know You love them and want to be their comfort when they hurt. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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LESSON 9

Jesus Talks With a Samaritan

John 4:1-30, 39-42

(KBC Study Bible, pages 1152-1154)

Character Word

Honesty – *truthful words and ways*

If we're honest like the Samaritan woman, we will realize our need for Jesus. Only He can give us eternal life.

I can be honest and share the truth about Jesus with others.

Memory Link

“Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.’”

John 14:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 1171)

Weekly Challenge

If we're honest like the Samaritan woman, we will realize our need for Jesus. Only He can give us eternal life. Make a list of names below who will you share this truth with this week.

DAY 1 READ: John 4:1-8 (KBC Study Bible, pages 1152-1153)

DO: Draw a picture of something you like to drink when you are thirsty. Jesus said He is living water and those who drink from Him will never thirst again.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for taking care of us all the time. I want to long for You to be in my life, the way I long for this drink when I am thirsty. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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DAY 2 **READ: John 4:9-12** (KBC Study Bible, page 1153)

THINK: The woman in our story seems to have very few friends. Think about the people you are around during the day at school, in the neighborhood, and other places. Look for someone who needs a friend and try to get to know him or her better.

PRAY: Father God, I ask that you help me be a true friend. I want to show others the love You have shown to me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 **READ: John 4:13-15** (KBC Study Bible, page 1153)

DO: Take a cup and fill it up with a little water from each of the water faucets in your house. Think about how good water is for you. Remember that Jesus offers living water.

PRAY: Father, thank You for the water you provide. Thank You for the way Your living water satisfies. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 **READ: John 4:28-30** (KBC Study Bible, page 1154)

THINK: After the woman talked to Jesus she left and hurried to the town to tell others about Jesus. She was very excited to tell what she knew about Jesus. Who do you know who needs to know Jesus? What will you tell them?

PRAY: Dear God, please help me to share what I am learning about you with others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 **READ: 1 John 1:8-9** (KBC Study Bible, page 1355)

DO: If you confess your sins, God is faithful to forgive them. He keeps His word. You can trust Him. Take time now and confess your sin to God.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for being faithful to forgive me when I confess my sins. Thank you for sending Jesus to pay the price for my sin. In His name, Amen.

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PRAY: Dear God, please help me to share what I am learning about you with others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 **READ: 1 John 1:8-9** (KBC Study Bible, page 1355)

DO: If you confess your sins, God is faithful to forgive them. He keeps His word. You can trust Him. Take time now and confess your sin to God.

PRAY: Dear God, thank You for being faithful to forgive me when I confess my sins. Thank you for sending Jesus to pay the price for my sin. In His name, Amen.



LESSON 12

Elijah Defeats the Prophets of Baal

1 Kings 18:20-39

(KBC Study Bible, pages 378-379)

Character Word

Courage – *standing up for what I believe in; bravery*

Elijah was a prophet of God who was alone in standing up for God, but he showed great courage. As a result, people trusted in God as the One True God.

I can have courage because God is on my side.

Memory Link

“The Lord, He is God! The Lord, He is God!”

1 Kings 18:39b (KBC Study Bible, page 379)

Weekly Challenge

Ask an adult in your home to tell you one way they showed courage this week.

DAY 1 READ: Deuteronomy 31:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 218)

THINK: We just talked about Elijah and how he stood alone against people who wanted to spread lies about the One True God. This verse reminds you that you are never fully alone because God always stays with you.

PRAY: Jesus, thank You for never leaving or forsaking me. You promise to be with me through everything in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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DAY 2 READ: John 16:33 (KBC Study Bible, page 1174)

DO: Jesus tells us to take heart, which is another term for having courage. Today, do something nice for someone you do not know.

PRAY: Jesus, thank You for overcoming the world and being bigger than anything in this world. Help me to have more courage. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 READ: Proverbs 28:1 (KBC Study Bible, page 698)

THINK: How do you live? Do you fear a lot of things that may not even happen? If Jesus is your forever friend, you can be as bold as a lion! Have you made Him your forever friend yet?

PRAY: Jesus, help me to be bold. I do not want to live in fear. I trust You to take care of me. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 READ: 2 Timothy 1:7 (KBC Study Bible, page 1317)

SHARE: Choose someone in your family to share this Bible verse with today. Someone else needs to know that God does not want them to live fearfully. This will also make you more courageous as you share Truth with people you love.

PRAY: Jesus, thank You for giving me a spirit of power, love and a sound mind. Help me be courageous in my life and also to take care of other people. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 READ: Isaiah 41:10 (KBC Study Bible, page 768)

DO: Draw a picture of a hand, then draw pictures or write words of all your worries on the hand. Remember that the Lord is holding you up!

PRAY: Jesus, You are stronger than I will ever be. You care for me. You hold me up when no one else can. Thank You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

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LESSON 15

Abigail Risks Her Life

1 Samuel 25:2-42

(KBC Study Bible, pages 315-317)

Character Word

Humility – to value others above yourself; opposite of prideful, arrogant, and conceited

Abigail’s humble, soft answer really helped resolve an angry situation. Remember, pride causes arguments but humility helps you get along with others.

With God’s help, I can humbly speak the truth.

Memory Link

“A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.”

Proverbs 15:1 (KBC Study Bible, page 681)

Weekly Challenge

If you have siblings, and you get into an argument, remember to respond with humility rather than anger.

DAY 1 READ: Bible Explorers (KBC Study Bible, page 315)

TALK ABOUT: Talk about how Abigail showed humility and stopped a big fight from happening. Talk with someone at home about a way you can show humility to someone at school that may treat you or a friend unfairly.

PRAY: Thank You, Jesus, for wanting to be my forever friend. Help me see ways to show humility to those around me. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

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DAY 2 READ: 1 Peter 5:5-7 (KBC Study Bible, page 1351)

DO: God wants us to respect adults and submit to their authority. Focus on humbling yourself this week and responding with kind words.

PRAY: Lord, help me show respect to my parents and teachers and choose to be humble instead of thinking of myself and what I want. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 3 READ: 1 Samuel 25:24-42 (KBC Study Bible, pages 316-317)

SHARE: Who can you share this story with? Tell someone the story of Abigail's soft answer and how responding with humility kept an angry situation from getting worse.

PRAY: Father, I ask that You help me be the one who can use a soft answer in times of anger. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 4 READ: 1 Samuel 17 (KBC Study Bible, pages 304-307)

THINK: Read another story about David. Most people probably know David best as the one who killed a giant named Goliath. David had great confidence in God, and knew he could do anything with God's help.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for always being with me. Help me remember to rely upon You always. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 5 READ: James 4:6 (KBC Study Bible, page 1343)

THINK: Think about humility. God does not like it when we are proud and arrogant. He wants to bless us when we show humility.

PRAY: Dear God, help me to humble myself in situations that can lead me to anger and pride or make wrong choices. In Jesus' name, Amen.

DAY 2 READ: 1 Peter 5:5-7 (KBC Study Bible, page 1351)

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LESSON 18

Philip Tells a Friend About Jesus

John 1:43-51

(KBC Study Bible, pages 1149-1150)

Character Word

Friendliness – *knowing, liking, and accepting other people just the way they are*

Philip found his friend Nathanael and told him about Jesus.

I can tell my friends about Jesus.

Memory Link

“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations.”

Matthew 28:19a (KBC Study Bible, page 1069)

Weekly Challenge

Be intentional and tell your friends about Jesus. Friends invite friends to come to Jesus!

DAY 1 READ: John 15:13 (KBC Study Bible, page 1172)

THINK: Jesus showed how much He loved you by giving His life to pay for your sin. He wants to be your Forever Friend. Read the tip-in pages “God Loves You and Has a Plan for Your Life” between pages 626-627 in your KBC Study Bible. Think about Jesus’ sacrifice to make you a friend of God.

PRAY: Thank You, Jesus, for wanting to be my Forever Friend. Thank You for loving me and saving me from my sins. In Jesus’ name, amen.

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DAY 2 **READ: Proverbs 17:17** (KBC Study Bible, page 684)

DO: When does a friend show love? At all times! Loving others is a choice that can sometimes be difficult. There may be a time when you don't want to act in a loving way, but your challenge today is to choose to show your love. Find a way to show love today, even when it's hard.

PRAY: Father God, help me treat my friends with love. Help me act in a loving way. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3 **READ: Ecclesiastes 4:9-10** (KBC Study Bible, page 709)

DO: Friends help each other. Find a piece of paper. On one side, draw a picture of you helping a friend. On the other side, draw a picture of a friend helping you. Thank God for your friends and ask Him to help you be a better friend to others.

PRAY: Thank You, God, for the friends I have who help me. Father, help me be that kind of friend. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4 **READ: John 1:35-42** (KBC Study Bible, page 1149)

DO: Andrew just heard Jesus speak and immediately went and told his brother, Simon Peter. Who is the first person you will tell today about Jesus?

PRAY: God, I ask you to lead me to a friend today who needs to know about You. Help me tell them about how you want to be their Forever Friend. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5 **READ: Luke 5:1-11** (KBC Study Bible, page 1110)

THINK: Jesus invited Simon, James and John, who were fishermen, to leave their fishing nets and come follow Him. What are some things that keep you from spending time praying and reading your Bible? Video games? Sports? What if you took time each day before you played to stop and pray and read your Bible? This would show you desire to make your relationship with Jesus a priority.

PRAY: Jesus, please help me spend time reading my Bible and praying before I start my day. I want you to lead me and help in all I do. In Jesus' name, amen.

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LESSON 19

Jesus Prays In the Garden

Luke 22:39-46

(KBC Study Bible, page 1142)

Character Word

Determination – to continue on, regardless of the circumstances

Jesus showed determination by completing God’s will even though it meant His suffering and death.

I can be determined to continue on, regardless of the circumstances.

Memory Link

“Nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.”

Luke 22:42b (KBC Study Bible, page 1142)

Weekly Challenge

Talk with a parent or grandparent about determination and what that looks like in their life.

DAY 1 READ: Philippians 4:13 (KBC Study Bible, page 1298)

THINK: Whatever you face in your life, Jesus will give you strength to get through. He will give you strength and determination.

PRAY: Lord, thank You giving me Your word. I can do anything because You promise to give me strength. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

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DAY 2 **READ: Psalm 44:18** (KBC Study Bible, page 590)

DO: Play “Follow the Leader” with your siblings or friends. You lead and have them copy what you do, then have someone else lead and you follow them.

PRAY: Lord, help me to follow You with my whole heart the way I can follow others with my feet. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY 3 **READ: 2 Chronicles 15:7** (KBC Study Bible, page 460)

THINK: Do you work your hardest, every day? At school? At home? How can you work harder? Your work will be rewarded in many ways as you continue to grow.

PRAY: Lord, thank You for making me strong. Help me to try harder in everything I do. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY 4 **READ: 1 Corinthians 2:1-5** (KBC Study Bible, page 1252)

SHARE: Talk to your parents about how determination does not always mean being the best, but about trying hard and not giving up. Ask them to tell you how they show determination as an adult.

PRAY: Lord, I am so glad I do not have to be the best at everything! Help me have confidence in staying determined anyway. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

DAY 5 **READ: 2 Thessalonians 3:13** (KBC Study Bible, page 1310)

DO: Meet someone new! Make a new friend. Not because you need a new friend, but because someone needs you.

PRAY: Lord, help me to see how to do good to people. I may not be able to do much by myself, but You have put people in my life to help me. Help me to help others. In Jesus’ name, Amen.

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
